

MORNING AND EVENING DU‘Ā’ – ALL UNITS

On the authority of Abū Malik al-ʿAshʿariyy, may Allāh be pleased with him, that the Messenger of Allāh, may Allāh’s blessings and peace be upon him, said:
“**Whenever one of you enters upon the morning, let him say:**

ʿaṣbaḥnā wa ʿaṣbaḥa l-mulku li l-lāhi rabbi l-ʿālamīn, al-lāhumma ʿinnī ʿasʿaluka khayra hādha l-yawm, faṭḥahū wa naṣrahū wa nūrahū wa barakatahū wa hudāh, wa ʿaʿūdhu bika min sharri mā fīhi wa sharri mā baʿdah.

We have entered upon the morning and all dominion, which belongs to Allāh, Master of all creation. O Allāh, I ask you for the goodness of this day—its victory, its help, its light, its blessings, and its guidance. I take refuge in you from the evil in it and the evil that follows it.

Then when he enters upon the evening, let him say similar to that.”

It was related by Abū Dāwūd.

When you enter upon the evening, say:

ʿamsaynā wa ʿamsa l-mulku li l-lāhi rabbi l-ʿālamīn, al-lāhumma ʿinnī ʿasʿaluk khayra hādhihi l-laylah, faṭḥahā wa naṣrahā wa nūrahā wa barakatahā wa hudāhā, wa ʿaʿūdhu bika min sharri mā fīhā wa sharri mā baʿdahā.
